



Job Position: Dune Restoration Intern

Pay rate: \$10.50/hour

Hours worked: 100 hours over 12 weeks, schedule dependent on weather

Dates of employment: November 2017 – January 2018 (Potential for longer employment)

The Dune Restoration Intern, under the supervision of the Programs Coordinator will:

- Work with other dune stewards and sometimes independently removing invasive plants from the dunes.
- Supervise and work with volunteers involved with the Drop-in Restoration and Dune Ecosystem Restoration Team programs.
- Supervise California Conservation Corps work crews as needed.
- Work closely with the Programs Coordinator and Executive Director on special projects.
- Work a minimum of 100 hours. Additional hours may be available.

Successful candidate should have an interest in ecology, aptitude for fieldwork, and enjoy learning new concepts. Past experience with volunteer coordination and/or restoration is desirable. Candidate must be able to perform strenuous physical activities, such as walking in sand, removing weeds, hauling up to 50 lbs, and working in rain, wind, and sunny conditions in the sand.
