- Open to 3rd and 4th graders
- Any media may be used
- Must be 2-dimensional (winners will become an outreach sign)
- Size should be 8.5 x 11 inches
- One entry per student
- Art must depict, or somehow represent the Western Snowy Plover
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will be chosen in each of the following categories: *Most Lifelike, Best Message, Most Creative, and Best Habitat*
- **Deadline is May 1st!**
